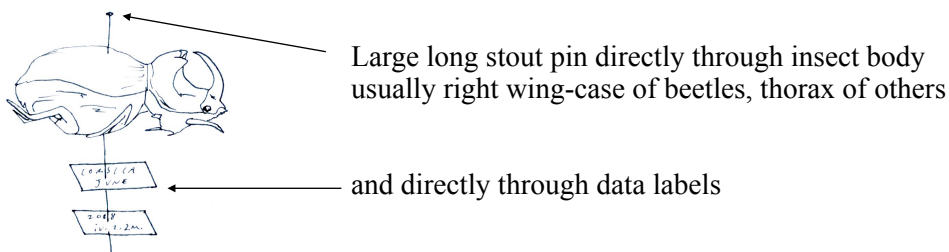
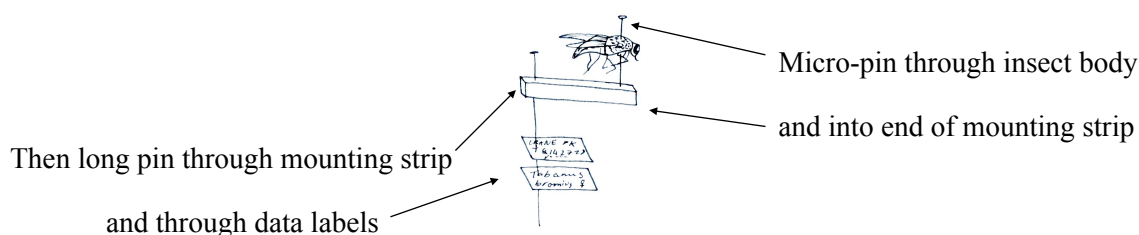


STANDARD INSECT MOUNTING STYLES

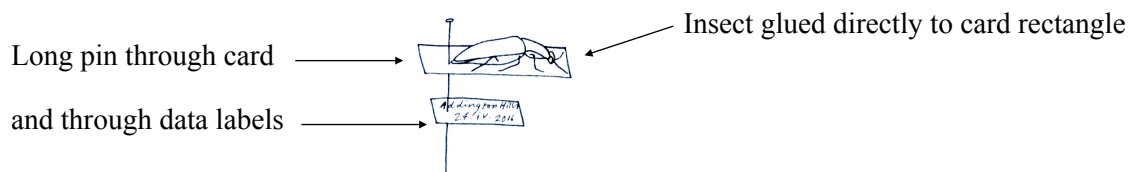
1. Direct pinning — suitable for large, heavy beetles, bumblebees etc



2. Pinning to mounting strip — best for winged insects: flies, bees, wasps



3. Carding — best for non-winged insects: beetles, leaf bugs, fleas, earwigs
